This form relates to the correct use of certificates. The form is an instruction for certificate holders, informing them about how to use an issued certificate correctly. It also describes terms and conditions on which a certificate will be valid and will remain to be valid.

Validity of the certificate

This certificate is solely valid in its original form and under the conditions stated on the certificate concerned. Any change made on an original certificate makes this certificate no longer suitable for use. It is not allowed to use a certificate for any other product as the certificate concerned specifies, not even if this product shows similarities to the approved and certified product.

Ownership of the certificate

The certificate is a proof of DCI that the certified product is according to specified requirements. The certificate as a document remains at all times the property of DCI. DCI can claim it back if the holder no longer fulfils the conditions: "Correct use of Certificate".

Duplicates of the certificate

A duplicate of the certificate does not prove that the original certificate has been issued. The Netherlands Institute for Yacht Survey (DCI) may issue duplicates against payment. The Netherlands Institute for Yacht Survey (DCI) will authorise and sign the duplicates according to the requirements.

For a remuneration DCI can supply several original specimens of the certificate in the languages English, German or Dutch.

Wrong use and/or misuse of the certificate

When a valid certificate will not be used correctly or will be misused, the person who recorded this fact is obliged to inform DCI immediately.

When wrong use and/or misuse has been detected, DCI will withdraw the certificate directly. DCI is obliged to take all necessary corrective actions, such as:

- Publication of the transgression that the certificate has been used not correctly and/or has been misused;
- To take legal action.

Note

DCI advise the certificate holder to hand out the Certificate of Conformity (module G) when the involved product is being delivered. A Type approval Certificate (module B) should be kept carefully at the manufacturer. The buyer of a certified product always receives a Declaration of Conformity from the manufacturer.
